Job Purpose:	You will support and assist the RGN and Sister as they provide the highest possible standards of Nursing Care, by providing personal assistance to Residents, working within a multi disciplinary team.

Professional Responsibilities:

- Personal assistance to individual residents which may include help with feeding, washing, dressing, bathing and toileting etc
- Attending to residents who are confined to bed and helping reposition as necessary for their care and comfort.
- Encouraging residents when necessary with activities, both within the home and outside the home.
- Observing any unusual behaviour/incidents involving residents and reporting to a senior member of staff.
- Contribute to the assessment of the resident's response to nursing care and participating in any divisional/therapeutic activities involving the residents.
- Reporting any accidents/untoward incidents immediately to trained staff.
- Help maintain high standards of cleanliness and hygiene in all areas of the home.
- Assist in distributing resident's laundry and ensuring clothing is well maintained.
- Maintaining confidentiality within the home with regards to residents and staff.

Secondary Duties

- Accompanying residents when necessary on activities/visits outside the home.
- Any other duties that may be considered relevant.

General Responsibilities:

To be aware and familiar with the home's policies relating to:

- COSHH control of Substances Hazardous to Health
- Health and Safety
- Infection Control
- Moving and Handling
- Fire Safety
- Protection of Vulnerable Adults

Also

- Ensures the economic use of all supplies and equipment. Maintaining all these resources in a satisfactory condition and reporting any faults/breakages
- Completes and maintains relevant paperwork
- Reports all accidents, complaints and defects in equipment to the Nurse Manager
- Ensures the safe keeping of patient's belongings and valuable in accordance with the Home policy
